Additional Benefits

Arrowhead Golf Club has banquet facilities available for your outings, a variety of menus are available, from \$7.50 picnics up to \$16.50 steak dinners. We can also make arrangements for your outings and we can help with gifts, and door prizes as well, at a discount, through our Pro-Shop.

There are also driving cart passes available that provide the use of a cart for 11 rounds at the cost of almost 9 rounds, this is a \$121.00 value for only \$105.00 for 9 holes, and a \$209.00 value for only \$180.00 for 18 holes.

Members receive a 10% discount on Pro Shop items. Members also have an in-house charge account and receive 10% riding cart discounts when charging cart rentals.

Tournaments are held for Members and their guests throughout the season. GHIN, as described below, is available to our members for a small fee. Arrowhead Golf Club is a member of the RDGA,USGA, NGF, and several other Golf organizations.







Golf Handicap and Information Network

GHIN (pronounced like gin - the "H" is silent) stands for Golf Handicap & Information Network. The United States Golf Association founded it in 1981 to provide handicap computation and other electronic services to golf clubs. Seven million golfers and 8200 clubs in the country belong to GHIN. Over 52 use the GHIN system in the Rochester area alone. GHIN is located at Golf House in Far Hills, N.J., home of the United States Golf Association. Its programming staff operates a mainframe computer, which communicates with amateur golf associations and their member golf clubs throughout the U.S. Computations are based on scores entered into the system (along with the Course Rating and Slope Rating of each course played, and the date of play). Should any score appear unusual, the GHIN computer reports it to the club's handicap committee chairman for verification. Golfers scores are entered into the system by your club. Scores are transmitted electronically from your club's personal computer to the system by modem. Scores of a GHIN golfer who plays at another GHIN club as a guest or as part of a tournament can be entered into the system at the site club and routed by the system to the golfer's home GHIN club. At the close of each score collection period (every two weeks) GHIN's mainframe performs computations. GHIN golfers are issued plastic membership cards that identify them as members. Through stick- on labels issued throughout the season (mid May thru mid October), each golfer augments the membership card with his or her latest USGA Handicap Index and 20 score history.
