David D'Ettorre - 138 lbs. (2-12)







Hartley - Fitzsimmonds

Leadership award

Ed Fitzsimmonds began assisting with the Brockport Wrestling team during the 1967 – 68 season. He put on several summer clinics for the Brockport wrestlers and worked closely with then coaches Rudy Aceto and Andy Nazzaro.

R.E. Hartley has been the Brockport Modified Wrestling coach since 1985. He comes from wrestling rich Pennsylvania, and he wrestled for a small college in the state of Iowa. Mr. Hartley was Head Wrestling Coach at Hampton H.S. near Pittsburgh, as well as Port Allegany H.S. (also in PA). Rea also served as a middle school Wrestling coach in Clearfield, PA, before heading to Brockport. Coach Hartley has also served as an official on both the high school and college levels, and remains actively involved in freestyle officiating, a position he has held for the past 29 years. Coach also worked with Mr. Brown and Mr. Bush for one year, and coached the Brockport Modified Wrestling team from 1985 until 2000. He continues to work as a clinician at the Clarion Summer Wrestling Camps, where he has always managed to encourage Brockport wrestlers to come along.

This award was developed at the end of the 1969 – 70 season to honor Coach Fitzsimmonds. This award was "updated" at the end of the 1998 – 99 season to honor Coach Hartley for his contributions and commitment to the Brockport Wrestling program since 1983.

This award goes to the wrestler who has contributed to the total program in the manner that both Ed and Rea have contributed. The award was established to help bring unity to the team, and it is important that the recipient be a **good team man**. The wrestler must be a hard worker, polite, a gentleman, and a good teammate. He must work arduously-doing all he can on and off the mat in the school and the community to promote the sport of wrestling. The winner of this award is recognized for the qualities of hard work, dedication, and loyalty.

Jeff Brown

Commitment to Excellence Award

This award is to be given to an individual who best exemplifies the characteristics of Jeff Brown and his commitment to excellence. The award was established to honor Jeff: an individual who exemplified that commitment in bringing Brockport Wrestling to elite status during the 1970's and 80's.

Jeff Brown was a parent, a teacher, an administrator and a coach. Although he has retired from the coaching and teaching professions, he will always be known as "Coach." Jeff started his coaching career in Brockport in 1971 as a Junior Varsity coach. He later became the Varsity Wrestling coach in 1973, and with his assistant, Craig Bush, achieved a career record of 130 wins, 30 losses and one tie. The wrestling teams under Coach Brown's guidance won four divisional titles and two Monroe County titles. Jeff produced ten individual Monroe County champions, eight Sectional champions and four State representatives, all of whom were State place finishers. In 2000, Jeff was inducted into the Section Five Wrestling Hall of Fame.

The criterion for this award is: the individual must be committed to becoming the best wrestler possible. To do so, the individual be dedicated, hard-working, always looking to improve himself, have leadership qualities, and must have the respect of his fellow teammates, coaches and community. These are characteristics that allowed Jeff Brown and his teams to have so much success.

Mr. Brown served as head principal at Brockport High School for eleven years. Jeff and his wife Marilyn live in the Clarkson area. We are proud to say that Jeff is still an avid Brockport Wrestling supporter.
